Youth - Three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes, one (1) minute rest between rounds.

Junior - Three (3) rounds of two (2) minutes, one (1) minute rest between rounds.

7. SCORING SYSTEM

AIBA Scoring System - **10 Point Must-Scoring** System will be used.

R&J are sent by National Federations.

For the fair – play and successful competition, **IT'S MANDATORY TO NFS TO BRING THEIR AIBA R&J – 1, 2 or 3 Stars (Delegation NFs more than five members).**

10. REQUIREMENTS

a. **All Boxers must bring along with them:**

- Record book with annual medicals duly completed and updated
- Current and valid Passport

b. **Each Team Delegation must bring the following:**

- National flag 1x1.5 m
- National anthem (on MP3 or CD)

c. **Boxer's Uniform:**

- Each boxer must bring two sets of uniform.
- The colours of these two sets of uniform must be in accordance with AIBA Technical and Competition Rules.

11. TRANSPORTATION

All the delegates will be welcomed at *International Airport Alicante* or *International* by the staff of the Organizing Committee to be transported to the Hotel.

The Organizing Committee will provide local transportation to all participants between the airport and the hotel and the competition venue free of charge. Each National Federation will organize and pay for the travel arrangements for their athletes and officials from their country to and from *International Airport Alicante* to their country.

- **Distance International Airport Alicante to Competition Venue and accommodation:** ±21' (16KM)
- **Distance accommodation to Competition Venue:** ±5' walking (500 m.)

12. ACCOMMODATION

Allocation of single, double, triple or quadruple HOUSE required and the rooming list must be emailed to the LOC at feb.boxamyouth2021@gmail.com before **7 NOVEMBER, 2021.**

Important: Only Boxers and Team Officials and timely registered in the Final Form will be allowed to stay in this hotel.

a. Room Rates for Team Delegations are as follows:

FOR /TRIPLE OR QUADRUPLE OCCUPANCY (3/4 Persons for HOUSE)	EUR 55 per all inclusive. Person, per day,
FOR DOUBLE OCCUPANCY (2 Persons per HOUSE)	EUR 70 per all inclusive. Person, per day,
FOR SINGLE OCCUPANCY (1 Person per HOUSE)	EUR 90 per all inclusive. Person, per day,

Each house has two bedrooms, one single with a double bed and the other with three single beds.

The room rates are provided for the tournament period only and apply from **NOVEMBER 22, 2021.**

Teams arriving earlier than the NOVEMBER 22 or leaving later than NOVEMBER 28 will have to cover all the expenses.



b. Payment of Hotel Room Charges:

All travel expenses must be covered by participating teams. The Spanish Boxing Federation will provide local transportations for all the teams the 22 to 28 of November.

All participating federations are required to pay of the total amount for their accommodation by bank transfer on **NOVEMBER 12, 2021. To complete the registration to the Tournament it's mandatory to pay the accommodation by bank transfer.**

15. VISA

Those countries that need entry Visas for Spain must send us:

- a. **List with names of Participants.**
- b. **Birth Dates.**
- c. **Passport Numbers.**
- d. **Copies of Passports.**

Not later than 22 OCTOBER and contact Embassy of Spain in their countries in advance or the nearest Consulate of Spain in neighboring countries. The organizing committee will provide all the necessary facilities for all the participating countries to enter into Spain. To ensure and speed up the visa application process, please remind to fill in the final Entry form carefully and send it to the organizing committee in due time. Based on this form the organizing committee will issue a formal visa support letter to facilitate the visa procedures.

Please be informed that we'll not accept any visa support request after October 22.



COVID-19 PROTOCOL FOR TEAM DELEGATIONS

All official members of Team Delegations, whether they are competitors or staff, international or local are obligated to:

- Present, on arrival, an **individual COVID-19 medical certificates (PCR test made within 72 hours before arrival) with a negative result.**
- Complete an individual medical survey not earlier than 72 hours before the arrival that will be sent to your email.
- **All participants will be subjected to a test to detect the COVID-19 virus, upon arrival at ALANNIA COSTA BLANCA RESORTS;** avoiding possible last minute infections. Each test will cost € 25 per person.
- We inform you that **you can request a PCR test to return to your country.** We indicate that each of the tests has a price of € 100 (the Spanish public health does not carry them out), if **you are interested you have to send us the number of people and day to do the test.**
- To organize your arrival in Spain and your participation in the Tournament, we inform you that you must send us the three annexes that our government requires to be completed by participants in sporting events:
 - Personal Location Form and Responsible Statement (Annexes) - Completed by all members of your National Team.
 - Team Manager Certificate (Annex) - Completed by the Team Manager or Head Coach.
- At the request of the Spanish Ministry of Health, we inform you that any person from countries of the European Union, associated Schengen area and Third Countries, have to fill out a record hosted on the website of the Ministry of Health: <https://www.mscbs.gob.es/profesionales/saludPublica/ccayes/alertasActual/nCov-China/spth.htm>)
- Appoint a COVID-19 contact person from the official Team Delegation list, who will be present during the Tournament and will be in charge of any COVID-19 related issues for their Team Delegation.
- Wear a mask at all times during the Tournament, with exceptions of:
 - boxers in training when it is not possible to wear it
 - participants in respective hotel rooms, where it is the choice of participants
 - participants during their meals only when seated at their dining table
- Observe social distancing at all times (1,5 m), except for boxers during their bouts and during warming up with their coach.
- Avoid entering hotel rooms of other participants under any circumstances.
- Avoid any contact with individuals who are not on the training camp as workers, other athletes...
- Submit to contactless temperature screening by the LOC and/or local health authorities at any time during the Tournament
- Submit to COVID-19 testing at any time during the Tournament on request of LOC COVID-19 Managers and/or local health authorities



- Follow all instructions of LOC COVID-19 Event Managers, including following isolation, quarantine, observation procedures and provision of detailed contact tracing in case of need
- Timely report all COVID-19 protocol violations during the Event to EUBC/LOC COVID-19 Managers
