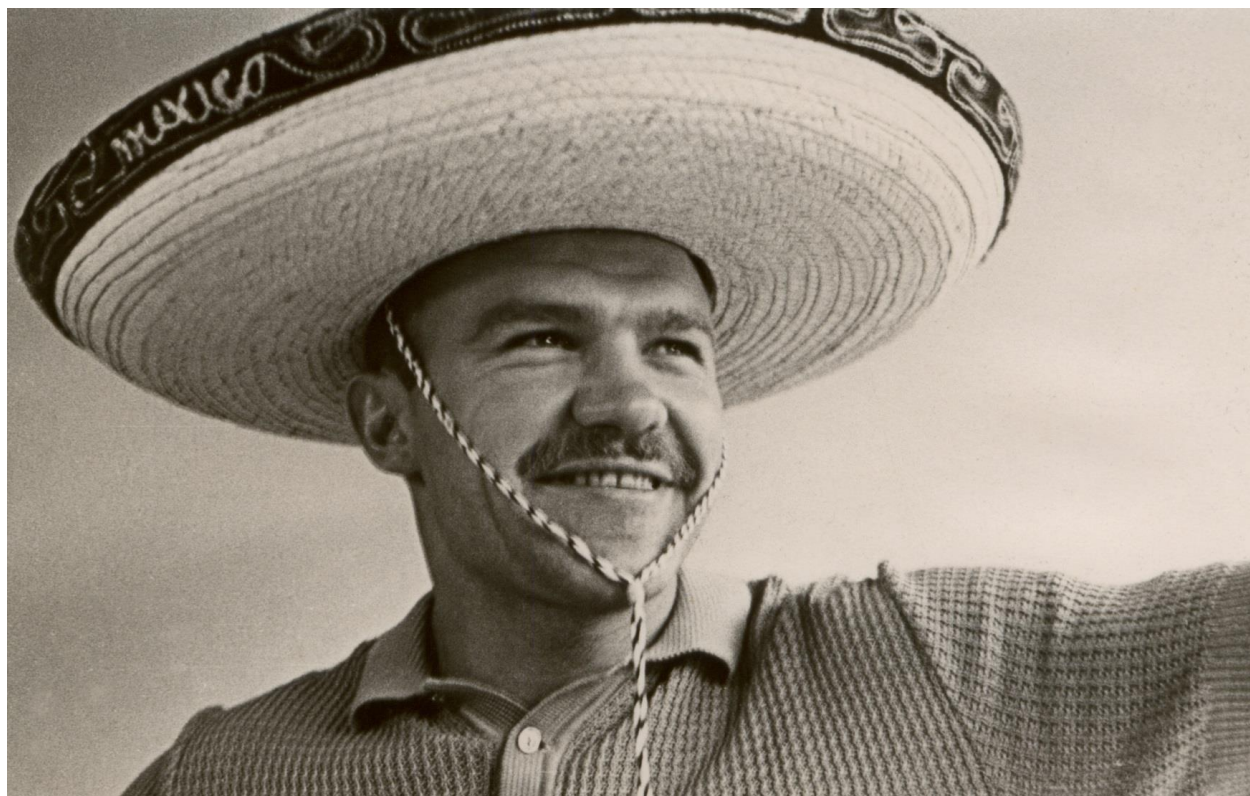

INVITATION

XVIIth International Danas Pozniakas Youth Boxing Tournament will be held on **15th-20th of March, 2022** in Vilnius, Lithuania.

Hereby we have the great pleasure to invite your National Association/Federation to participate in the Tournament.

During the Tournament days (15th-20th of March, 2022) the organizer offers accommodation & meals for boxing teams (max. 18 persons per team: 13 boxers + 5 officials) and for non AIBA R/J price:

- **50 euros per day per person in double room.**
- **70 euros per day per person in single room.**

The host will provide free of charge accommodation & meals for **AIBA R/Js only**.

The price of accommodation & meals for:

- additional nights (team members coming before 15th of March and leaving after 20th of March) are **80 euros** per day per person;
- additional boxing team persons - **80 euros** per day per person.

XVIIth International Danas Pozniakas Youth Boxing Tournament will be held in Vilnius College Grand Hall, Studentu str. 39.

Accommodation and meals will be at the Hotel Art City Inn, J. Jasinskio str. 14, Vilnius.

We await your preliminary numerical entries by **21st of February** (application form is attached). Final entries with categories, names, total number of the delegation members, travel details and room numbers must be sent at the latest by **1st of March** (application form is attached).

Day of arrival is 15th March and departure day is 20th of March, 2022.

REGULATIONS

The competition will be held according to the rules of the AIBA for 13 weight categories (48 kg, 51 kg, 54 kg, 57 kg, 60 kg, 63,5 kg, 67 kg, 71 kg, 75 kg, 80 kg, 86 kg, 92 kg, 92+ kg) for men.

The competition is open for athletes born from **1st of January 2004 to 31st of December 2005**.

Each National Association/Federation may nominate one boxer for each weight category. The organizer takes maximum 16 boxers in each weight category.

Teams and their attendants according to the following rule:

1-2 boxers	+ 2 attendants	
3-6 boxers	+ 3 attendants	+ 1 AIBA R/J 1-3 Stars
7-13 boxers	+ 4 attendants	+ 1 AIBA R/J 1-3 Stars

Payment for accommodation:

All delegations must pay the full room charges (accommodation & meal) in advance of the time of check-in by cash or bank transfer. Bank transfer in Euro should be made not later than **1st of March**.

Please, ask for invoice before completing the payment to settle the total amount.

Team Delegations will not be able to receive accreditation cards and hotel room keys if the payment will not made in full.

Please note that every boxer is requested to show his international (AIBA) competition record book at the first weight-in. Every boxer has to bring a red and blue competition uniform.

Please be noted every athlete must have European Health Insurance Card or other type of insurance.

The Referee/Judge must be recognized by AIBA and must show an international record book before the beginning of the competition.

VISA

Organizer will grant assistance to all delegations on visa matters.

INSURANCE

All participants are requested to get their own travel and medical insurance. Organizers strongly recommends to each participant to have „European Health Insurance Card”.

COVID-19 PROTOCOL FOR TEAM DELEGATIONS

According to the official „Event Management Protocol during COVID-19 Pandemic“ Vilnius Boxing Academy will organize the event at the highest safety measurements.

All official members of Team Delegations, whether they are competitors or staff, international or local are obligated to:

- Present, on arrival, an individual COVID-19 medical certificates (PCR test made within 72 hours before arrival) with a negative result.
- The certificate must be in English or bilingual with English as one of the languages. (Provision to be amended as per local requirements at the time).
- Present prior to receiving accreditation an individual Declaration of Absence of COVID-19 Symptoms for at least 14 days prior to Event arrival day (to be provided separately).
- Present prior to receiving accreditation an individual COVID-19 Liability Release Waiver (to be provided separately).
- Always wear a mask during the Event, with exceptions of:
 - o boxers in the ring during bout, where it is prohibited;
 - o boxers in the warm-up area, where it is the choice of athletes;
 - o participants in respective hotel rooms, where it is the choice of participants;
 - o participants during their meals only when seated at their dining table;
 - o boxers on the medal podium during the medal ceremonies.
- Always carry Event accreditation during the Event.
- Always observe social distancing (1,5 m), except for boxers during their bouts and during warming up with their coach.
- Avoid entering hotel rooms of other participants under any circumstances.
- Avoid any contact with individuals who are not accredited at the Event.
- Submit to contactless temperature screening by the organizers and/or local health authorities at any time during the Event period.
- Submit to PCR and/or other COVID-19 testing at any time during the Event period on request of organizers and/or local health authorities.
- Follow all instructions of organizers and/or local health authorities, including following isolation, quarantine, observation procedures and provision of detailed contact tracing in case of need.
- Timely report all COVID-19 protocol violations during the Event to organizers and/or local health authorities.
- In addition to the individual obligations, participating National Federations must:
 - o Appoint a COVID-19 contact person from the official Team Delegation list, who will be present during the Event and will be in charge of any COVID-19 related issues for their Team Delegation.

- Ensure the delegation of all Team Delegation members, including R&Js, who do not have serious underlying health conditions known to increase the risk of lethal outcomes from COVID-19.
- Secure single accommodation for their delegated R&J throughout the Event.
- Ensure that the registration procedures are timely and completely followed (last minute changes to the number of participants, rooming lists etc. will not be allowed).

There will be no mandatory quarantine periods for Team Delegations in the Tournament host country provided there is no positive COVID-19 test result.

In case of amendments to the protocol the LOC will inform all participants in timely manner.
