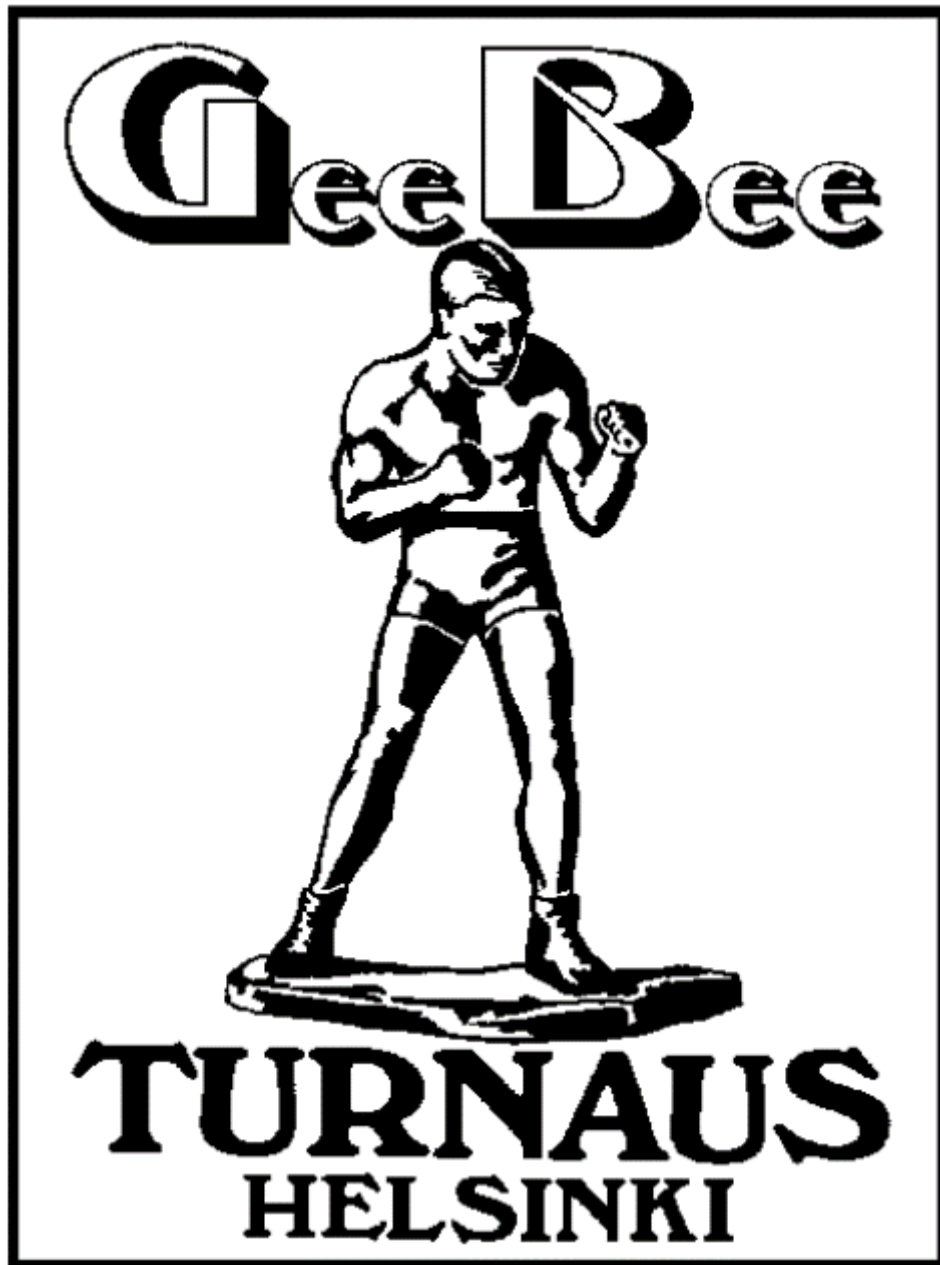

The tournament period is April 6th–11th, 2022.

The competition period is April 7th–10th, 2022.

The deadline for preliminary numerical entries is **January 28th 2022**. REGULATIONS

The Tournament shall be organized according the current IBA Technical and Competition rules.

Weight categories

Elite Men: 12 weight categories
51 kg, 54 kg, 57 kg, 60 kg, 63,5 kg, 67 kg,
71 kg, 75 kg, 80 kg, 86 kg, 92 kg, +92 kg

Elite Women: 3 weight categories
52-54 kg, 54-57 kg, 57-60 kg

Participation is limited to one (1) boxer per country per weight category

Teams – Official Delegation

1–2 Boxers	1 second/coach
3–6 Boxers	2 seconds/coach + AIBA R/J (1–3 stars)
7-15 Boxers	3 seconds/coach + AIBA R/J (1–3 stars)

Accommodation and meals

The LOC will provide accommodation and meals during the tournament period for the price of 75 EUR per day per person in twin rooms. Single rooms cost 110 EUR per day per person. The price includes three (3) meals per day. Extra persons can be accommodated for 130 EUR per day per person.

LOC is requesting non-refundable accommodation & meal deposit to be paid via bank transfer by participating National Federations prior to the event not later than March 31st 2022.

Requirements

All boxers must bring along with them:

- International IBA Competition Record Book (medical examination stamped by doctor max. 12 months old)
- Passport
- Two sets of Boxing Uniforms (red/blue) according to IBA Technical and Competition rules

Transportation

All delegations will be welcomed at Helsinki Airport (HEL) by LOC. Transportation from/to the airport or Helsinki harbor to/from the competition venue and the hotel is provided by LOC.

Insurance

All participants are responsible for their own medical insurance. For European Citizens we highly recommend the European Insurance Card. The organizer does not provide medical insurance.

COVID-19 PROTOCOL FOR TEAM DELEGATIONS

All members of Team Delegations, whether they are competitors or staff are obligated to:

- 1) Before travelling
 - Register to FINENTRY service online: <https://www.finentry.fi/>
- 2) Present on arrival
 - a certificate of a complete and valid vaccination series (either one or two doses depending on the vaccine). At least 7 days must have passed since the last vaccine dose has been received OR
 - a single certificate that the person has recovered from covid-19 virus and has gotten one dose of vaccine. It is equated to a complete covid-19 vaccination series. OR
 - EU digital COVID certificate that proves the person has recovered from covid-19 within 6 months.
 - In addition to the aforementioned requirements, the person must present a negative covid-19 test result of less than 48 hours. The result of a PCR or an Antigen test is accepted.

- 3) On arrival to Finland
 - Submit to a free PCR test provided by the local authorities
- 4) During the event
 - Always wear a medical face mask (type FFP2 / FFP3 without valve or type IIR) with exemptions of:
 - i. boxers during the bout where it is prohibited
 - ii. boxers in the warm-up area where it is optional
 - iii. participants in respective hotel rooms where it is the choice of participants
 - iv. participants during their meals only when seated at their dining table
 - v. boxers on the podium during the award ceremonies
 - Apply social distancing at all times (1,5 m) except for boxers during their bouts and during warming up with their coach
 - Carry accreditation at all times during the event
 - Avoid any contact with individuals who are not accredited at the event
 - Avoid entering hotel rooms of other participants under any circumstances

- Avoid any contact with outside Tournament individuals
- Submit to COVID-19 testing at any time during the Tournament on request of LOC COVID-19 Managers and/or local health authorities
- Follow all instructions of LOC COVID-19 Event Managers including following: isolation, quarantine, observation procedures and provision of detailed contact tracing in case of need

- Each Team Delegation must appoint a COVID-19 contact person from the official Team Delegation list who will be present during the Tournament and will be in charge of any COVID-19 related issues for their Team Delegation
- Timely report all COVID-19 protocol violations during the Event
