INTERNATIONAL BOXING TOURNAMENT 2021

The Czech Boxing Association has the pleasure to invite your boxing association to participate in the **51th International Elite Men's and Women's Boxing Tournament** "GRAND PRIX" which will be held from **04th to 09th May 2021** in **Usti nad Labem** city.

Participation

Tournament regulations (entries):

The competition is open for Men and Women Boxers from 19 to 40 years of age (born between January 1.2002 and December 31, 1981).

Weight categories for MEN: 52, 57, 63, 69, 75, 81, 91 and +91 kg.
for Women : 51, 57,60, 64, 69, 75kg.

NB! The organizers keep right to modify the weight categories particular national federation/association can participate in and will notify your national federation immediately.

Competition rules

- Bouts will consist of 3 x 3 minutes rounds with 1 minute break between each round.
- The tournament will be carried out according to the AIBA rules. All boxers must have red and blue competition uniforms. Organizer will provide AIBA approved gloves.
- For the fair – play and successful competition, it is highly recommended to NFs to bring their AIBA R&J – 1, 2 or 3 Stars.

Prizes

- In all weight categories, first, second and third place winners will receive Cups for winners.

Financial conditions

- Travel costs to Prague or to Ústí nad Labem and back home are the responsibility of the respective association
- All participations will be accommodated on their own cost in amount 50 EUR per Person and day for all participants/70 EUR for single rooms/ with full board.
- Delegations arriving before 04th May 2021 or leaving after 09th May 2021 are responsible for their expenses during the extra time.
- The host of the tournament is responsible for providing accommodation and full board, training facilities and transportation from/to Prague airport arrival/departure including local transportation during the tournament. No daily money will be given.
- Extra persons have to pay 60 EUR per day.
- The LOC will provide complimentary transportation from/to Prague International Airport according to arrivals and departures of the delegations including local transportation. No daily money will be given.
- Each boxer and each R/J must have his international AIBA Record book as well as medical exams up to date.
- All the members of the foreign teams participating in the tournament must have a valid health insurance.

Visa regulations

Those countries who need entry visa for Czech republic should contact the Czech republic Embassy in their countries or the nearest consulate in the neighbor countries and send the copies of the team members civil passports, as well *Name list* of delegation containing home address of each member of delegation to the Czech Boxing Association in advance. Also please write the City where you are going to apply for entry visa, day of arrival to The Czech Republic, planed day of departure from The Czech Republic. Taking in to the consideration the European Union visa issuing regulations, we kindly ask you send requests for visa assistance not later than **07th March 2021.**

COVID-19 PROTOCOL FOR TEAM DELEGATIONS

According to the official „Event Management Protocol during COVID-19 Pandemic“ Czech Boxing Association will organize the event at the highest safety measurements. All official members of Team Delegations, whether they are competitors or staff, international or local are obligated to: - Present, on arrival, an individual COVID-19 medical certificates (PCR test made within 72 hours before arrival) with a negative result. The certificate must be in English or bilingual with English as one of the languages. (Provision to be amended as per local requirements at the time) - Present prior to receiving accreditation an individual Declaration of Absence of COVID-19 Symptoms for at least 14 days.

Present prior to receiving accreditation an individual COVID-19 Liability Release Waiver (to be provided separately)

- **Wear a mask at all times during the Event, with exceptions of:**

- boxers in the ring during bout, where it is prohibited
 - boxers in the warm-up area, where it is the choice of athletes
 - participants in respective hotel rooms, where it is the choice of participants
 - participants during their meals only when seated at their dining table
 - boxers on the medal podium during the medal ceremonies
- Carry Event accreditation at all times during the Event
 - Observe social distancing at all times (1,5 m), except for boxers during their bouts and during warming up with their coach
 - Avoid entering hotel rooms of other participants under any circumstances
 - Avoid any contact with individuals who are not accredited at the Event

- Submit to contactless temperature screening by the LOC and/or local health authorities at any time during the Event period
- Submit to PCR and/or other COVID-19 testing at any time during the Event period on request of EUBC/LOC COVID-19 Managers and/or local health authorities
- Follow all instructions of EUBC and/or LOC COVID-19 Event Managers, including following isolation, quarantine, observation procedures and provision of detailed contact tracing in case of need
- Timely report all COVID-19 protocol violations during the Event to EUBC/LOC COVID-19 Managers In addition to the individual obligations, participating National Federations must:
 - Appoint a COVID-19 contact person from the official Team Delegation list, who will be present during the Event and will be in charge of any COVID-19 related issues for their Team Delegation
 - Ensure the delegation of all Team Delegation members, including R&Js, who do not have serious underlying health conditions known to increase the risk of lethal outcomes from COVID-19
 - Secure single accommodation for their delegated R&J throughout the Event
 - Ensure that the registration procedures are timely and completely followed (last minute changes to the number of participants, rooming lists etc. will not be allowed).

There will be no mandatory quarantine periods for Team Delegations in the Tournament host country provided there is no positive COVID-19 test result.

In case of amendments to the protocol the LOC will inform all participants in timely manner.

- Preliminary entries shall be sent until **19 March 2021**.
- Preliminary numerical entries with weight categories of boxers shall be sent until **09 April 2021**. The organizers keep right to modify the weight categories particular national federation/association can participate in and will notify your national federation immediately.
- Final entries with names and personal details until **16 April 2021**.
- NOTE: Entries received after the dates stated above should not be accepted.
