# COMPETITION REGISTRATION-RELATED FINANCIAL PENALTIES

In order to support EUBC event organizers and ensure timely submission of all registration information, EUBC has introduced a system of financial penalties for non-compliant National Federations:

Offence	Sanction Amount <i>EUBC Championships</i>	Sanction Amount <i>EUBC International Tournaments</i>	Remarks
Late registration/replacement of a boxer	€ 200	€ 100	MUST be paid prior to Sport Entries Check
Late registration/replacement of a coach, team manager, doctor, cut technician, physio or R&J	€ 100	€ 50	MUST be paid prior to Sport Entries Check
Registration of a new boxer at the Sport Entries Check without any prior notice	€ 500	€ 250	MUST be paid prior to Sport Entries Check & confirmed by respective National Federation
Failure to appoint an appropriately certified R&J	€ 500	€ 500	Applicable to Team Delegations with three or more registered boxers / MUST be paid prior to Sport Entries Check

**EUBC encourages all National Federations to plan all registration procedures timely and diligently to avoid these penalties.**

# EUBC COMPETITION HOST FEES

All Championships and Tournament host fees must be paid within 1 month from the date of departure of the corresponding competition.

# EUBC ACCOMMODATION & MEALS PRICE

The accommodation & meals price that can be quoted to participating Team Delegations is strictly applicable per table below. The price must include breakfast, lunch and dinner.

# ACCOMMODATION & MEALS DEPOSIT AT EUBC TOURNAMENTS AND CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Due to difficulties faced by LOCs in the past with no-shows and frequent/last-minute changes in team delegation compositions, the EUBC Executive Committee has approved and encourages LOCs to request non-refundable accommodation & meals deposits to be paid via bank transfer by participating National Federations prior to the event.
- Alternatively, LOC's are entitled to request a letter of financial guarantee from the participating National Federations in order to secure the requested accommodation capacity.
- LOCs must still offer the National Federations an option paying for accommodation & meals by cash on site
